SAGEBRUSH SAFARI General Information

The Sagebrush Safari is located in east county San Diego. Be aware that this is a very remote location. Bring food, water, bike parts and tools. You will not be running around the corner for supplies.

Food: There will be a vendor there cooking and selling BBQ, water and soda, Drew's BBQ, Great Food!

Course Descriptions: Probably the most diverse and challenging course in the series. A fast paced start with a big climb gives way to a fast fun single track. Wide open fire roads, a hike a bike, and a long single track descend toward the finish. Categories 2 & 3 will go approximately 18 miles, while the Pros and Cat 1's will add the climb to Mount Pinus which adds about 7 miles to their ride.

Directions: Northside of Lake Morena County Park. Take the 8 Freeway east to exit 51, Buckman Springs Road. Head South on Buckman Springs Road 3.3 miles; turn right on Corral Canyon Road go approximately 1.5 miles to the venue.

Camping: There is a developed campground on the south side of the lake, about 7 miles from the race start. For reservations call 619.579.4104.

There will be RV and tent camping; **NO HOOK UPS, AND NO WATER, ABSOLUTELY NO OPEN CAMP FIRES; SELF CONTAINED PROPANE BBQ ONLY.** Camping is \$10 per vehicle. Parking \$5 per vehicle.
